Aetna New Business Checklist

Small Group Market

- Aetna allows the 1st and 15th of the month effective dates.
- Aetna will allow the 28th of the month if the group has prior coverage on that effective date and will be terminating as of then.
- New Business deadlines are:
 - o 1st of the month effective dates are due the 25th of the previous month.
 - 15th of the month effective dates are due the 10th of the month.
- Aetna allows National Access on all plans, including HMO, if member resides in the service area.
 - CT, DC, DE, MD,NJ, NY, PA and VA
- For employees outside of the service area, they must enroll in Aetna's Open Access MC plans to access coverage.
- Aetna's pediatric dental benefit is embedded in the medical and is not able to be removed from the product; however, you won't see an additional charge for it.
 - It only applies to children 19 and under. There is no family benefit.
 - This benefit will kick in after you have met your medical deductible and will vary based on medical plan in force.

Individual Market

- Aetna does not allow brokers to sell Individual.
- The client must go direct to Aetna to buy the product.
- The individual pediatric dental product is built into the medical plan and it can't be removed.
 - However, like on the group side, you won't see an additional charge for it.
 - It only applies to children 19 and under. There is no family benefit.
